8. Future plans of action for next academic year (2021-22)

Teaching learning process in covid-19 will be carried out by online teaching learning methods, such as Google meet, Google classroom, YouTube, video lectures, etc. More innovative processes will be adopted by institution in teaching learning. Time table will be prepared taking into consideration covid-19 pandemic guidelines. Faculties will be called in campus for work by following instructions given by education Department of State Government and University. Faculties will be motivated for online teaching and work from home as well as from college campus. As our college is single faculty college and number of full time teachers are minimum. All faculties will be called in campus by following covid-19 norms. All other activities and programs will be conducted online. NSS program, extension outreach activities, social awareness activities will be conducted online. Seminar, conference, workshops, webinars will be organised online. Library issue of books will be carried out as per covid-19 pandemic situation and students will be motivated to use N- list as a knowledge resource. Students will be encouraged and motivated to attend online programs. Guest lectures will be organised online, anti ragging programs will be organised online. Internal complaint committee (Anti Sexual Harassment Cell for Women) programs will be organised online or as per situation. Competitive exam and career guidance programs will be organised online or offline. Certificate and value added courses will be conducted online. Online programs on soft skills, life skills and language and communication skills will be organised online. Birth and death anniversary of social leaders will be celebrated by following all rules of social distancing. ICT computing skills will be taken online .skill enhancement courses will be taken online. Seminar presentation by students, internal continuous assessment will be taken online as well as offline by following covid-19 social distancing rules and regulations. All faculties in the institution will be motivated to attend online FDP, orientation, refresher and short term courses. Cultural activities will be conducted online for example, singing, debate competition, prashna manjusha (quiz) essay writing competition, etc. Every department in the institution will organise online activities. Every faculty in the institution will be motivated for writing quality research papers and paper publication in UGC approved journals. All faculties will also motivated to create awareness about covid-19 pandemic immunity boosting diet, care, prevention and vaccination in society and community through online platform .Solar panel system in the college will be expanded to satisfy more percentage of annual power requirement of the institution made by renewable energy sources. Compost making pit will be constructed to prepare organic compost from organic waste produced in campus such as dry leaves of plants, food wastage, peels of fruits, etc. Institution has optimum infrastructure facilities for sports (indoor and outdoor) and Gymnasium, students will be motivated to use this infrastructure by following covid-19 pandemic situation guidelines. Faculties will be motivated to send minor /major research proposals to UGC and various funding agencies. Unnat Bharat Abhiyan sanctioned proposal to the institution in February 2021, will be run by involving all faculties and students. UBA activities will be implemented in 5 adopted villages by following social distancing and covid-19 pandemic rules and regulations. Village survey and household survey will be conducted by students in five adopted villages. Based on village survey, need based action plan of every village will be prepared and send to MHRD, Delhi through District collector for the development of rural area in Purna taluka. Child guidance and nutrition counselling centre established in Department of Home Science in 2017, all activities under this centre will be conducted by involving students and local community through online as well as offline platform. Through this centre more activities will be organised to create awareness and counselling regarding covid-19 immunity boosting diet care prevention and vaccination. Institution will take more efforts regarding motivation of girls education in rural area and continuation of girls education after marriage, as this is an institutional distinctiveness, institution shall take more efforts regarding these aspects. As per the covid-19 pandemic situation students and faculties will be motivated for online based education system, e- learning and online based internal continuous assessment.
